- Prepare articles, announcements, and other communications related to Adult missions *Tarheel Talk*, e-newsletter, social media, etc.
- Promote Week of Prayer for WMU NC and the Heck-Jones Offering, including a minimum of two speaking engagements during this special time of emphasis.
- Promote emphases for International, North American, Global and state missions.

Coordinate:

- Coordinate Missions Extravaganza conferences, displays and resources for Adults.
- Coordinate state training opportunities for Adults.
- Coordinate efforts to assist and encourage new and existing Women on Mission/Adults on Mission groups.
- Coordinate state-sponsored, hands-on missions and ministry events for Adults by:
 - o Planning and promoting events,
 - o Recruiting volunteers,
 - o Delegating leadership,
 - o And managing communication.
- Partner with:
 - Fellow WMU NC staff to further Adult missions education and ministry opportunities;
 - Other missions organizations and ministry partners to further Adult engagement in missions.
 - WMU NC leadership in churches and associations to plan ministry based on identified needs.

Represent:

- Represent WMU NC on committees, task forces, and/or special groups related to Adults as guided by the EDT.
- Represent Adult needs and issues to the WMU NC staff, to the WMU NC Executive Board and at the Annual Meeting.

Execute Administrative Duties:

- In conjunction with the EDT, project and plan for budgetary needs.
- Manage the budget for Adult missions and ministries.
- Stay current on trends and demographics, programming and curriculum, methods and schools of thought that relate to Adult missions and ministry.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the EDT.
- Report to EDT.

- Must demonstrate a passion for the Great Commission and model a missional lifestyle.
- Must demonstrate Christian character and faithful church membership.
- Must have a thorough knowledge of Baptist principles and WMU's organization and purpose, especially as relating to Adults.
